Upon arrival in Bandipur (elevation: 1,030 meters/3,380 feet), check-in to your hotel or guesthouse and start your exploration of the historic town on foot. Bandipur is famous for its Newari architecture and traditional culture, so take some time to immerse yourself in the local ambiance. One of the must-visit sites in Bandipur is the Siddha Gufa (cave), which is the largest cave in Nepal. After the cave, take a short hike to the Tundikhel viewpoint (elevation: 1,540 meters/5,050 feet) to enjoy panoramic views of the Himalayas. In the evening, savor a traditional Newari dinner before retiring for the night in your Bandipur accommodation.

Day 02: Ramkot Hike and Thani Mai Temple Visit

Start your day with a hearty breakfast before embarking on a hike to the nearby Magar village of Ramkot (elevation: 1,700 meters/5,580 feet). Take in the scenic views on the way and explore the village while learning about the lifestyle and culture of the Magar people. Visit the Thani Mai Temple (elevation: 1,720 meters/5,640 feet), a popular pilgrimage site for both Hindus and Buddhists. In the afternoon, return to Bandipur and take the time to relax for the rest of the day in your accommodation.

Enjoy breakfast and check out of your hotel or guesthouse. If your departure time permits, use your free time to explore more of Bandipur or do some last-minute shopping before departing from the town (elevation: 1,030 meters/3,380 feet).
