Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Kathmandu

Arrive at Tribhuvan International Airport in [Kathmandu](#). Welcome, meet, and assist our Going Nepal representative & transfer to the hotel. Welcome drink followed by tour briefing. Stay Overnight in [Kathmandu](#).

Overnight at four-star hotel

Day 2: Full - Day Kathmandu Sightseeing

Early morning Breakfast at the hotel, after breakfast check out from the hotel and proceed to explore [Kathmandu](#). Our first stop will be [Patan Durbar Square](#): Located about 5km south of [Kathmandu](#), [Patan](#) is one of 3 royal cities in the valley. A destination for connoisseurs of fine arts, [Patan](#) is filled with wood and stone carvings, metal statues, and ornate architecture, including dozens of Buddhist and Hindu temples, and over 1200 monuments. After finishing the trip drive to [Bhaktapur Durbar Square - Bhaktapur Durbar Square](#), located in the center of [Bhaktapur](#) city, is a conglomeration of pagoda and shikhara-style temples grouped around a fiftyfive-window palace of brick and wood. The square is one of the most charming architectural showpieces of the Valley as it highlights the ancient arts of Nepal.

Overnight at four-star Hotel

Day 3: Kathmandu City Tour

Breakfast and drive for a city tour of [Kathmandu Durbar Square](#), [Swyambhunath Stupa](#), Lunch at City restaurant, in the afternoon, visit [Bouddhanath Stupa](#) and [Pashupatinath Temple](#).

Overnight at four-star Hotel

Day 4: Fly to Paro – Thimphu

Early morning flight (depending on your flight time) to Bhutan (Please check the flight timing) Upon your arrival at Paro airport our guide will be there to welcome you and transfer you to Thimphu. After Lunch visit the Memorial Chorten (temple) built in memory of the late 3rd King. Visit Changangkha Lhakhang, the oldest temple in the valley offering a nice view of the valley. Enclosure where national animal, Takins are kept and drive to visit the largest and newly built statue of Buddha offering magnificent view of entire Thimphu valley. After 5PM, visit the fortress of Thimphu, Tashichho Dzong, which houses the throne of the king.

Overnight: Thimphu

Altitude: 2300m Dinner

accommodation at Hotel, in Thimphu.

Day 5: Thimphu – Punakha

Morning visit the School of Arts and Crafts where students learn 13 different arts used predominantly in Bhutan, walk to the Folk Heritage Museum which is located next to the school, and end with a visit to the nearby National Library. After lunch drive to Punakha over Dochula pass, at 3150m, if the weather permits one can enjoy a spectacular view of the highest mountains of Bhutan at a sight that stretches almost 180 degrees. Walk around the 108 stupas and enjoy the view and the fresh air. Continue your drive to the warm valley of Punakha.

Overnight: Punakha | Altitude: 1350m

Dinner and accommodation at Hotel, in PUNAKHA

Day 6: Punakha Sightseeing

Morning drive to visit Punakha Dzong (fortress), which houses the most elaborated temple in the country. This is a fine example of Bhutanese rich Art and Architecture. Drive further up to visit the Souvenir Making Center for girls supported by Youth Development Fund. Interact with the students and back to the hotel for lunch. After lunch could relax on the balcony of the hotel to enjoy the view and nature. Or could go for an hour's hike to the temple of Khamsum Yuley Lhakhang or the temple of Chimi Lhakhang, the temple of fertility associated with religious art of phalus.

Overnight: Punakha

Dinner and accommodation at Hotel

Day 7: Punakha – Phobjikha

Check out from the hotel, and drive to the isolated valley of Phobjikha. The valley is

protected by the endangered Black Necked Cranes migrating to Bhutan every winter (early Nov to the End of February). The drive is very picturesque and worth every turn and climb. On arrival visit Gangtey Gompa, the only Ningmapa monastery which is the largest in western Bhutan. Phobjikha valley is a paradise for hikers and nature lovers. Later in the afternoon could relax in the hotel or could go for a nice short hike in the valley. This valley got electricity only recently. Farm house stay optional.

Overnight: Phobjikha | Altitude: 2900m

Dinner and accommodation at Hotel

Day 8: Phobjikha – Paro

Retrace the drive back to Paro. After lunch visit Paro Dzong (Fortress) on foot and continue walking through the oldest wooden bridge still in use. Continue further to stroll around the old Paro town and peep into some local handicrafts stores. Could get some opportunity to see the traditional game, Archery match going on. Evening back to the hotel and enjoy the facility in the hotel.

Overnight: Paro | Altitude: 2200m

Accommodation at Hotel.

Day 9: Paro Sightseeing

Morning drive to the base for the hike (2 hrs uphill) to Tiger's Nest, the most revered temple in the country that literally hangs on a granite cliff overlooking the Paro valley. Lunch in the cafeteria. Most of the day will go on the hike. Back to the hotel and enjoy the facility. Hot stone bath for available at the Client's personal cost. Farewell dinner in the town.

Overnight: in Paro

Day 10: Bhutan – Kathmandu

Breakfast at Hotel and transfer to the airport for Kathmandu UPON arrival in [Kathmandu](#) Transfer to Hotel, Day Free.

Overnight at four-star Hotel

Day 11: Drive to Pokhara

After Breakfast, Check out, Drive by Car to [Pokhara](#). Enjoy a 6/7-hour beautiful drive to [Pokhara](#)., Arrive & check in at Hotel, and rest. Later in the evening go boating in Phewa Lake (the second largest lake in Nepal) You may do self-boating at Fewa lake.

Evening free for personal activities on the lakeside market on own. Dinner and Overnight Stay in Pokhara in Four star-Hotel.

Day 12: Sunrise From Sarangkot and Sightseeing

Wake up early Morning for witnessing a Sunrise from a hilltop called Sarangkot. It will take around 45 minutes to reach Sarangkot from Pokhara, Lakeside. After watching the sunrise from the top, drive back to the hotel, have Breakfast, and after some rest proceed for Pokhara sightseeing where you will visit Bindabasini temple, Davis Falls, Seti Gorge, Gupteshwor Cave, and Tibetan Refugee Camp. Davis Fall and Gupteshwor Cave, Tibetan Camp, Mountain Museum, after finishing the tour drive back to the hotel and rest. Later in the evening you can go around the lakeside and enjoy the lake vibe. Dinner can be served around the lake or at the hotel and overnight at the four start hotel.

Day 13: Day Free in Pokhara

Today after breakfast, Cross the Lake by Boat and walk to World Peace Stupa, takes about 2/3 hours, and you may return the same way back. In the afternoon enjoy the lakeside and overnight stay in a four-star hotel.

Day 14: Pokhara – Chitwan National Park

Breakfast & drive to Chitwan National Park. (146 KM /5-6 hours). On arrival check into the Resort followed by a welcome drink and briefing about the jungle activities. Lunch at the hotel. After lunch, a briefing by the tour guide on the programs was arranged. You will be brought to the nearby ethnic Tharu Village where you will learn more about the life and lifestyle of the Tharus. Visit the National Park visitor's center where you can learn more about the history of the National Park and about wildlife. You will have a sunset view tour from the bank of Rapti River. Back in hotel. Dinner at hotel.

Accommodation: four-star Hotel

Day 15: Full day in Chitwan

Full-day Jungle activities, such as Elephant rides, Canoe rides, Elephant breeding centers, Jungle Walks,

Bird-watching etc. Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner at the resort.

Accommodation: four-star hotel

Day 16: Drive Chitwan – Kathmandu

The wake-up call is followed by tea/coffee. Breakfast, visit the elephant breeding center, and drive back to Kathmandu (186 KM/ 5 hours). Arrive in Kathmandu and

check into the hotel. The rest of the day is free to explore your own. Overnight at a hotel in Kathmandu at four-star hotel.

Day 17: Departure

Breakfast and Departure to the international Airport.
