Everest measuring 8848.86m (29031 feet) in height, Mt. Everest is the tallest peak on earth. This fact alone makes Everest one of the top destinations for all adventure seekers. The main attractions are glaciers, national parks, ancient monasteries, Sherpa culture, and up-close views of mighty Mt. Everest (Sagarmatha in Nepali).

Itinerary

Day 1: ARRIVAL KATHMANDU

Arrival and transfer to Hotel in Kathmandu, welcome dinner at fine dining restaurant in town. Overnight at 4-star Hotel.

Day 2: TREKKING PREPARATIONS & CITY TOURS

After breakfast, drive out for [Cultural and Heritage](#) sightseeing in [Kathmandu valley](#), our staff will prepare documentation and check your personal belongings which are necessary for trekking.

Overnight at 4-star Hotel.

Day 3: KATHMANDU- LUKLA

Early breakfast, drive to domestic airport, Fly to Lukla 2805m by plane (45minutes flight) And trek to Phakding 2610m. Dinner & Overnight at 4 star Hotel.

Day 4: PHAKDING- NAMCHE

Breakfast and start trek to Phakding to Namche Bazaar 3440m. Lunch will be served enroute. Dinner & Overnight at Yeti Homes.

Day 5: ACCLIMATIZATION REST IN NAMCHE

Acclimatization day at Namche Bazaar 3440m. Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner & Overnight at Yeti Homes.

Day 6: NAMCHE TO KHUMJUNG

Breakfast and trek from Namche Bazar to Khumjung 3780m, Dinner & Overnight at Everest View Hotel, most luxurious resort in the region.

Day 7: KHUMJUNG - PANBOCHE

Breakfast at EVH and trek to Panboche via Porche 3901m. Lunch enroute, from today you will accomodating at best available lodges, Dinner & Overnight at best available Lodge.

Day 8: PANBOCHE - DINGBOCHE

Breakfast at Pangboche and trek to Dingboche 4410 m. Lunch enroute, you will accommodate at best available lodges, Dinner & Overnight at best available Lodge

Day 9: ACCLIMATIZATION DAY

Second acclimatization day at Dingboche 4410 m.

Day 10: DINGBOCHE- LOBUCHE

Dingboche to Lobuche 4910 m. Lunch enroute, you will accommodate at best available lodges, Dinner & Overnight

Day 11: LOBUCHE - EVEREST BASE CAMP

Lobuche to Everest Base Camp 5364m via Gorakshep 5180m. Lunch enroute, you will be accommodated at the best available lodges, Dinner & Overnight.

Day 12: GORAKSHEP-KALA PATTHAR- PHERICHE

Gorakshep to Kala Patthar 5545m. and trek to Pheriche 4240m. Lunch enroute, you will accommodate at best available lodges, Dinner & Overnight.

Day 13: TENGBOCHE - NAMCHE

Tyangboche to Namche Bazaar 3440m Lunch enroute, from today you will be accommodated at Yeti Homes.

Day 14: NAMCHE - LUKLA

Namche Bazaar to Lukla 2805m. Lunch enroute, from today you will be accommodating at Yeti Homes.

Day 15: LUKLA - KATHMANDU

After breakfast, take a flight from Lukla to Kathmandu, and transfer to Hotel Manaslu. Overnight.

Day 16: IN KATHMANDU

Rest and shopping in Kathmandu, evening farewell dinner followed by cultural folklore. Overnight at Hotel Manaslu.

Day 17: DEPARTURE

International Departure, check out, Transfer to International airport.

- Welcome dinner at hotel and short briefing of tour by guide
- Embark the adventure with a scenic flight to Lukla airport.
- Trek to Dingboche for an excellent opportunity to see wild animals, plants, flowers and Birds.
