Itinerary

Day 01: Arrival in Chitwan

Upon your arrival at the bus station or airport, a representative from going Nepal will meet you and take you to your hotel in Chitwan. Afterward, you will continue to explore the Chitwan which includes a visit to a nearby Tharu village to learn about their traditional lifestyle and culture. You can witness their customs, traditional dances, and unique clothing styles. After settling in and refreshing yourself, Dinner will be served at the hotel, and your tour guide will provide a briefing on the upcoming activities. You'll spend the night in Chitwan, ready to embark on a full day of sightseeing the following day.

- Elevation: approximately 150 meters (490 feet) above sea level.
- Meal plan: Dinner

Day 02: Full Day Chitwan Sightseeing

On day 2 of your Chitwan tour, you'll explore the Chitwan National Park to witness its diverse flora and fauna. You'll have the opportunity to take a safari, canoe ride, and jungle walk to get a closer look at the park's wildlife, including rhinoceros, deer, monkeys, birds, and occasionally even tigers. Lunch will be provided during the day's activities, and in the evening, you'll return to your hotel for dinner and prepare for the evening's cultural program, which features traditional Tharu dance and music. You'll spend the night in Chitwan, surrounded by the natural beauty of the area, before your full day of jungle activities the following day.

Day 03: Full Day Chitwan Sightseeing

On this day of the Chitwan tour, after breakfast, you'll continue exploring the rest of the Chitwan area. You will do a bird-watching tour along with visiting a crocodile breeding center, where you can see these incredible creatures up close and learn about their

conservation efforts. You'll be provided with lunch in the afternoon and in the evening, you'll return to the hotel for dinner and some leisure time to relax and reflect on your experiences in Chitwan. You'll spend the final night of your tour in Chitwan, where you can enjoy the tranquility and natural beauty of the area before your departure the next day.

- Elevation: approximately 150 meters (490 feet) above sea level.
- Meal plan: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 04: Departure from Chitwan

On the last day of your 3-night Chitwan tour, after breakfast at the hotel, you'll check out and prepare for departure. We will make arrangements for transportation to the bus station or airport based on your departure time. If your departure is scheduled for later in the day, you may have some free time to explore nearby areas or do some last-minute shopping before leaving Chitwan. This will mark the end of your memorable trip to Chitwan National Park.
