Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Kathmandu

Arrive at Tribhuvan International Airport in [Kathmandu](#). Welcome, meet, and assist our Going Nepal representative & transfer to the hotel. Welcome drink followed by tour briefing. Evening welcome dinner at a local restaurant. Stay Overnight in [Bhaktapur](#) at Bhaktapur Heritage.

Day 2: Full Day Bhaktapur Sightseeing and Transfer to Dhulikhel

Wake up early in the morning and check out from the hotel. And process for full-day Bhaktapur sightseeing. Our first visit will be to Bhaktapur Durbar Square. Bhaktapur Durbar Square, located in the center of Bhaktapur city, is a conglomeration of pagoda and shikhara-style temples grouped around a fifty-five-window palace of brick and wood. The square is one of the most charming architectural showpieces of the Valley as it highlights the ancient arts of Nepal. The golden effigies of kings perched on the top of stone monoliths, the guardian deities looking out from their sanctuaries, and the wood carvings in every place—struts, lintels, uprights, tympanums, gateways, and windows all seem to form a well-orchestrated symphony. The main items of interest in Durbar Square are: 55 Window Palace, the Golden Gate, the Nyatapola Temple, and the

Peacock Window. The Durbar Square is also home to many traditional handicraft shops, where visitors can purchase souvenirs and traditional Nepalese crafts. Stop for Dinner somewhere around. After Dinner back to the hotel, and overnight at Himalayan Drishya.

Day 3: Full Day Panauti and Namobuddha Sightseeing

Wake up early in the morning and check out from the hotel. And process for full-day Namobuddha and Panauti Sightseeing. Visiting the Namobuddha Monastery: The Namobuddha Monastery is a beautiful and peaceful place to visit, and it is home to a large number of Buddhist monks. Visitors can take part in prayer and meditation sessions, and learn more about the teachings of the Buddha. After visiting Namobuddha we will drive to Panauti and Visit the Indreshwar Temple: The Indreshwar Temple is a popular tourist attraction in Panauti and is one of the oldest temples in Nepal. It is dedicated to the Hindu god Shiva and is an important site for Hindus. Exploring the surrounding area: Panauti is surrounded by beautiful forests and hills, and there are many trails that visitors can explore. The area is also home to a number of small villages that can be visited on foot. Overnight at hotel Himalayan Drishya.

Day 4: Departure

It is finally time to bid farewell to this amazing country. Early morning breakfast at the hotel, check out, and transfer to the international airport. Our representative will transfer you to the airport from where you will catch your flight. Bid goodbye to this beautiful nation as you fly to your next destination.
