Itinerary

Day 01: Arrival in Chitwan

Upon your arrival at the bus station or airport, our representative will meet you and escort you to your hotel in Chitwan where you can freshen up and relax after your journey. Next, you will explore Chitwan and can take a village walk tour where you will have the opportunity to explore the nearby Tharu village to learn about its traditional lifestyle. In the evening you will be served dinner at the hotel. Your tour guide will also brief you about the upcoming activities during this time. This is followed by an overnight stay in Chitwan.

- Elevation: approximately 150 meters (490 feet) above sea level.
- Meal plan: Dinner.

Day 02: Full Day Chitwan Sightseeing

After breakfast, your full day of Chitwan sightseeing will commence, which includes a range of exciting activities. You will enjoy a jungle safari, a canoe ride down the Rapti River, elephant bathing, and a visit to the elephant breeding center. Lunch will be provided during the day's activities. In the evening, you will return to your hotel for dinner and you can enjoy a cultural program featuring traditional Tharu dance and music. You will be staying overnight in Chitwan.

- Elevation: approximately 150 meters (490 feet) above sea level.
- Meal plan: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 03: Departure from Chitwan

After breakfast, it will be time to check out of your hotel and depart from Chitwan. We will arrange transportation to the bus station or airport, depending on your travel plans. If you have some free time before your departure, you can explore the nearby areas or do some last-minute shopping.

- Elevation: approximately 150 meters (490 feet) above sea level.
- Meal plan: Breakfast.
