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KATHMANDU CHITWAN TOUR: A CULTURAL AND WILDLIFE ADVENTURE

Kathmandu is the capital and oldest metropolitan city of Nepal. The city is the urban core of the Kathmandu Valley in the Himalayas, and at the foot of the Himalayas, Chitwan is one of the few remaining undisturbed vestiges of the 'Terai' region, which formerly extended over the foothills of India and Nepal.

Includes

- All (airport to airport) transfer by private vehicles as per group size.

- Meals: 5 breakfasts, 2 lunches and 2 dinner
- 2 nights / 3 days Package in Chitwan National Park on Full-board with Jungle activities,

- Visit Tibetan carpet factory and Thangka painting while guided sightseeing tour in Kathmandu.
- Seasonal and regional festivals and unique experiences as per region.
- Visit of spiritual Places in the city areas and outside the city while by surface travel.

- Monumental areas entrance fees as per the itinerary levied by the government and local authorities.
- Professional licensed local English/other language speaking guide service in Kathmandu, and nature guide in Chitwan.

Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive in Kathmandu

Arrival at Tribhuvan International airport. Meet, welcome by our representative & transfer to the hotel. Welcome drink followed by tour briefing. The rest of the day is free for personal activities. Overnight in Kathmandu.

- Elevation of Kathmandu: 1363m
- Transportation: Private car/ Tourist bus
- Driving distance: 25-30min drive to Hotel
- Meals: Welcome Dinner

- Accommodation: 4-Star Hotel

Day 2: Full day Kathmandu Sightseeing

After Breakfast prepares yourself for another tour of Kathmandu City. Our first stop will be Bhaktapur Durbar Square which is also known as the city of devotees. After touring Bhaktapur Durbar Square, drive back to Kathmandu Durbar Square, also famously known as Basantapur Durbar and Hanuman Dhoka, which is the old Durbar Square in downtown Kathmandu. After completing the tour, we'll drive back to the hotel and rest. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

- Transportation: Private car/ Tourist bus
- Driving distance: 3-4 Hours
- Meals: BB
- Accommodation: 4-Star Hotel

Day 3: Transfer Kathmandu to Chitwan

Breakfast & drive to Chitwan National Park. (186 KM /5 hours). On arrival check into the Resort followed by a welcome drink and briefing about the jungle activities. Lunch at the hotel. After lunch, a briefing by the tour guide on the programs was arranged. You will be brought to the nearby ethnic Tharu Village where you will learn more about the life and lifestyle of the Tharus. Visit the National Park visitor's center where you can learn more about the history of the National Park and about wildlife. You will have a sunset view tour from the bank of the Rapti River. Back in the hotel. Dinner at the hotel.

- Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 4: Chitwan Safari Activities

Wakeup call followed by Breakfast at the hotel. After finishing the trip proceed to Chitwan Jungle Tour. Canoe ride along the Rapti river. This an excellent opportunity for Bird Watching and for seeing the 2 rare species of crocodiles; the Marsh Mugger and the fish-eating Gharial. Plus, Jungle walk and, on the way, back one can enjoy Elephant bathing. Back to the hotel. Rest & Relax. Lunch in the hotel. Elephant Safari/ Jeep Safari. An excellent opportunity to see four different kinds of deer, rhino, wild boar, monkey, leopard, sloth bear, and the Royal Bengal Tiger (if you are lucky). You will also encounter many other smaller mammals that have made Chitwan their home. Back at the hotel, Dinner in the hotel, and after dinner Tharu Cultural Dance Performances.

Overnight at the Hotel.

- Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 5: Transfer from Chitwan to Kathmandu

The wake-up call is followed by tea/coffee. Breakfast, visit the elephant breeding center, and drive back to Kathmandu (186 KM/ 5 hours). Arrive in Kathmandu and check into a hotel. The rest of the day is free to explore your own. Overnight at a hotel in Kathmandu. evening Farewell dinner.

- Transportation: Private car/ Tourist bus
- Driving distance: 5 Hours
- Meals: Breakfast
- Accommodation: 4-Star Hotel

Day 6: Departure

Breakfast & check out from the hotel. Timely transfer to the airport for flight to your onward destination.

- Meals: Breakfast
- Transportation: Private car / Tourist Bus
- Driving Distance: 25 Min
