11 Days Far Western Nepal Tour is specially designed for observing western Nepal culture, the importance of ethnic caste group settlement and adventure activities. Around 70 kilometers from Dhangadhi is Asia's greatest gathering of Swamp Deer at the Suklaphanta Wildlife Reserve. We join a collide with the wild to see this group. Not far from the Reserve we grasp a little move to the Jilmila Lake, where you can value the cool waters of the Himalayas.

The Royal Gardens of Tikapur are said to have helpful properties, which is the reason the King used to come and stay here. We visit this staggering greenery fenced-in areas in this journey and incorporate experiences of the neighborliness of the ethnic Tharus at a home remain, sailing down the Karnali and eating at a diner which makes everything out of Banana!

The element of this stand-out program, we barge down the Karnali River inside the National Wildlife Park of Bardia, straightforwardly into the center of the Park, while viewing the wild and in a perfect world some untamed life as we coast by. When we are in the diversion focus, we trade to our wilderness lodge and continue with the next day with an Elephant back safari. Adrenaline flood guaranteed!

Itinerary

Day 01: Arrival day at Kathmandu

Arrive at Kathmandu airport & transfer you to the hotel booked for the night. You will check in & refresh. In the afternoon, we will meet you in the hotel lobby and explains you the details of the entire tour. After the discussion, you will have welcome dinner with Going Nepal crew member at Nepal restaurant. Return to the hotel for the overnight.

Day 02: Fly Dhangadi and drive to Mahendranagar

Morning breakfast at the hotel, drive to the airport for daily flight to Dhangadi. Arrive at Dhangadhi airport drive to Mahendranagar, the most westerly town located about 5 km east of Indian Border. Visit of the longest suspension bridge of Nepal. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Mahendranagar.

Day 03: Hike to Jilmila Lake and explore

After breakfast 1-day- hike near Mahendranagar. We can enjoy being in a hilly forest impregnated with mint and lemongrass aromas. On the highest point of the hills, we will have a great view of India, as well as of the amazing scenery of the Terai on the way back. The highlight of this hike is the mysterious lake Jilmila.

Breakfast at Hotel. After breakfast drive to Suklaphanta Wildlife Reserve. Full day safari program. Overnight stay at tented camp.

Day 05: Drive Dhangadi, bird watching and cycling to the Jokhar Lake

Drive to Dhangadhi, Bird watching at Mohana River Corridor. Breakfast. Check-in in the hotel. Afternoon cycling to the Jokhar Lake. Dinner and overnight in Dhangadhi.

Day 06: Drive Chisapani and boating at Karnali River

After breakfast drive to Chisapani. It is a start point of the boating through the largest river of Nepal – Karnali River. After three hours of boating, we will reach Tikapur, which is famous for banana cuisine and wine. In the evening we will have our dinner in the beautiful Banana Resort!

Day 07: Visit Royal Garden Tikapur and drive to Bardia National Park

In the morning visit of the Royal Gardens of Tikapur. After lunch, drive to Bardiya National Park. Arrive Thakurdwara and discover Tharu Life and Culture. Amazingly unique Tharu culture and their tradition capture and spell a cast on the visitor. Dinner and Overnight at Lodge.

Accommodation:

Accommodation in Kathmandu on BB plan and on Mahendranagar, Dhangadi, Tikapur, Suklaphanta, Bardia, and Nepalgunj at AP plan. This tour is more designed for the star categories hotel. The meals comprised of American, Nepali & Chinese cuisines. The meals served on breakfast during welcome and farewell dinner is included within the price. Snacks, mineral water is included but alcoholic beverages are not included within the price. During the stay in Kathmandu, Mahendranagar, Dhangadi, Tikapur, Suklaphanta, and Bardia we provide 10 nights' double sharing accommodation in 4-star hotel, 3-star hotel, jungle lodge, and tent.

As we know that the trip can be canceled, or in those worst case scenario we need to be aware, so we highly recommend to purchase trip cancellation and travel insurance. This broad travel insurance offers you huge benefits including the coverage of trip cancellation and interruption, travel delays, loss of baggage and travel documents, baggage delay, medical expenses, and emergency assistance.

Climate and Weather:

A country with a diversified culture does have a diversified topography as well beginning from 60 meters to top of the planet 8,848 meters i.e. the top of Mt. Everest. We have arid season start from October until May and the rainy season (monsoon) from June to September. All season are better for the sightseeing but during the end of winter (end of March) is best for the clear tour.

Passport and Visa Necessities:

The foremost thing to confirm before traveling to this trek is to check your passport and its valid date. Passports must have at least 6 months' validity just after ending date of your trip. We must need your copy of passport and its full details sent either by fax or scan. While staying in Nepal you will need a visa which can be gotten in advance from the Nepalese Embassy in your country or you can even get on arrival at the airport in Kathmandu (Conditions: Within a peak season you need to wait long in the airport to get your visa). The general list of Nepalese visa fee is mentioned below and you can even surf thoroughly this web link as (www.nepalimmigration.gov.np)

Fees charged while delivering a tourist visa by the Mission or entry point:

US Dollars 40 or another convertible foreign currency equivalent for 30days multiple entry visas.

US Dollars 100 or another convertible foreign currency equivalent for 90days multiple entry visas.

Notwithstanding anything written in clause (a) and (b), no visa fee shall be applicable to the passport holder of member states of the South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation (SAARC) for 30 days.

US Dollars 25 or another convertible foreign currency equivalent thereto for 15days multiple entry visas.

Required Fees:

We need to have permission in many places in Nepal for a tour. Mostly the sightseeing tour of Nepal are listed in World Heritage list so, we need world heritages site entry permits. All these relevant entry fees are included/excluded in the given cost(according to a proposal) except the personal donations & contribution. Just in case of any such unassured conditions we will inform you if any additional fees are required or not before

you make a booking with us.

Information on Health and Medical Evidence/Assistance:

We need to know about our health and the medical information during our Nepal Tour. As mentioned earlier our squads are well-experienced travelers and are achieving the traveler's ambition since long. Trip Information

Q: How long hours do I have to walk each day?

A: There is no fixed time to walk each day. From a few minutes minimum to 1 hours' maximum, you shall walk. Check the itinerary to see how long you shall walk each day.

Q: How difficult is the tour?

A: The walk into the sightseeing area is easy ones. In some places, you have to face the stairs trials.

Q: What kind of food do I get there?

A: During a tour, you will find a different restaurant and lodge. Every restaurant and lodge serves the traditional Nepali meal Dal Bhat (rice and lentil soup). Many of them have western food on the menu. Soft drinks, snacks, and beer are available in most of the restaurant and lodge.

Q: What kind of clothes is needed for a tour?

A: The normal clothes that you wear is better for the tour.

Q: What type of shoes should I have?

A: For a tour, comfortable tennis shoes or sneakers is enough which should be kind of strong, well-made but light boots.

Q: What happens in the case of an emergency?

A: We are prepared for any emergency situation and know how to handle it. Our guides are trained in first aid and can deal with most of the basic ailments that occur during hiking. Every client should have his own insurance before coming to Nepal for the case of an emergency.
